



GARDEN CHECKLIST

April 2012

- Get your warm weather plants in the ground. Tomatoes, peas, beans, squash, peppers and melons, can get a head start now and be well established when the heat hits.
- Mulch and weed, keeping up on your mulching makes weeding so much easier and weeding now before things get overgrown will save your back this summer.
- Flower lovers, now is a great time to start bringing in your favorite perennials. It's a mild enough year they will get a good jump and that means early blooms.
- Feed what you've got, keep feeding the plants you've got with either compost tea or a good basic fertilizer like a 10-20-10.
- Get your water on, set up your watering system if you've taken it down for the winter or do yearly maintenance on the one you have. Now is a great time to get that watering schedule set up and in use.
