



## GARDEN CHECKLIST

May 2013

- Keep to your watering schedule, very very soon you may be adding a mid afternoon watering slot.
- Mulch, is going to be key this year, for keeping those late set plants from getting overrun by weed and grass.
- Feed those plants with some organic compost every other week or so.

Harvesting your early and cool weather crops, peas, spinach, lettuce, broccoli.

- Prep for harvest, get yourself ready for canning, preserving and eating the coming crops.

Continue rotational planting, spinach, peas, and carrot's as well as many other plants can be re-seeded for later harvests.

- If you haven't already prep and plant your summer veggies, tomatoes, okra, melons, squash...
